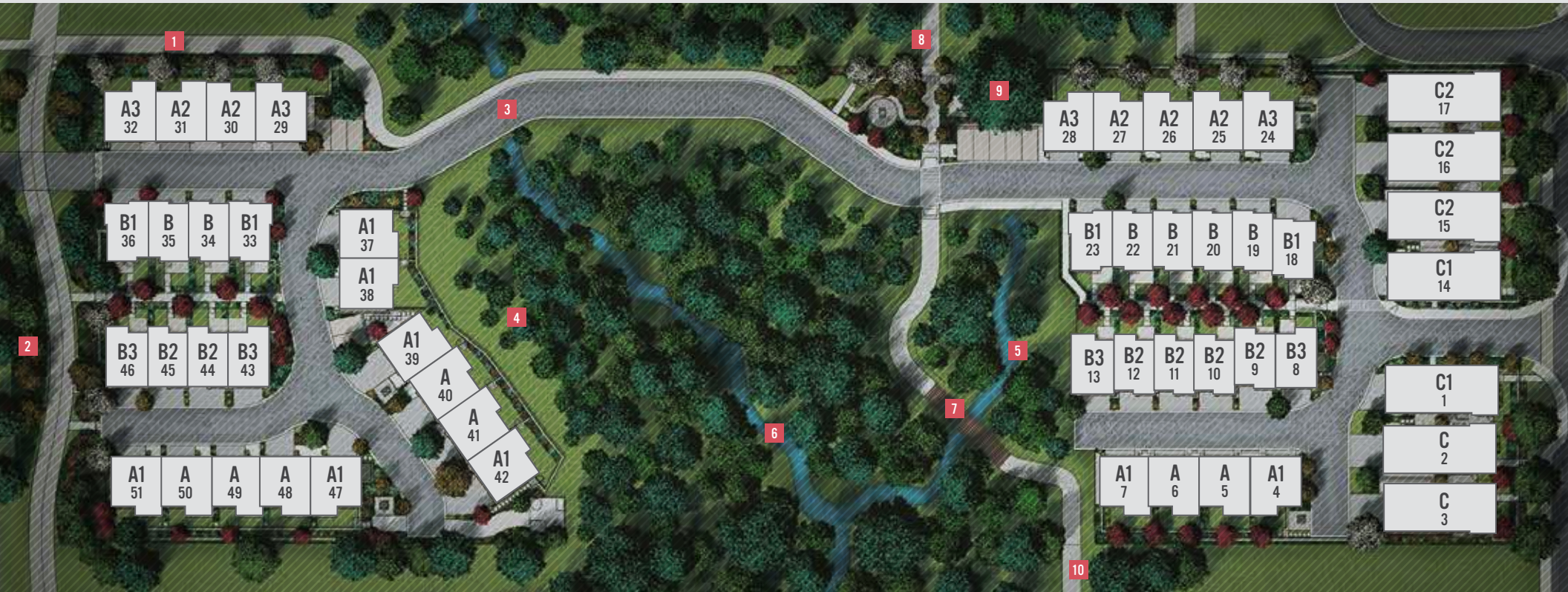


SITE PLAN
